PRODUCT DESCIPTION AND PROPERTIES

Cicavet'eau is an **external dressing** specifically designed to **support the natural regeneration of the skin** of fish and other aquatic animals.

Thanks to its **powder formulation that gels upon contact with water**, Cicavet'eau effectively **isolates the affected area from the external environment** while keeping the powder in place.

Its formulation helps maintain a **clean and protective environment**, favourable to **natural tissue regeneration**.

The product is **painless, non-irritant, alcohol-free**, and contains **no aggressive excipients**. Once gelled, Cicavet'eau forms a **lightly adherent surface layer**, preventing contamination by environmental impurities and limiting product loss through friction.

Cicavet'eau is designed for use on all external parts of the fish's body. It is not recommended for use on gills.

Depending on the application area and specific conditions, the dressing may remain in place for **one to several hours**.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove the animal from the water.

Gently pat the lesion and surrounding area with a compress to obtain a moist (not wet) surface. This improves the adhesion of Cicavet'eau.

2 Apply a thin layer of Cicavet'eau powder on and around the affected area. Spread the powder slightly beyond the wound edges to enhance adhesion and protect the surrounding skin.

Immerse the animal in water to activate gel formation.

After application, gently return the fish to the water to trigger the gelling process. Avoid applying a thick layer, which could reduce adhesion.

For multiple small lesions, a fine water mist spray can be used to initiate gelling while keeping the fish out of the water.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- For older or irregular skin areas, once the surface has been cleaned and damaged tissue removed, Cicavet'eau can be applied as a protective dressing, alone or in combination with another local care product.
- Important: This product does not replace appropriate veterinary supervision.

 Always consult an aquatic veterinarian or fish health specialist in case of persistent or ulcerative lesions.
